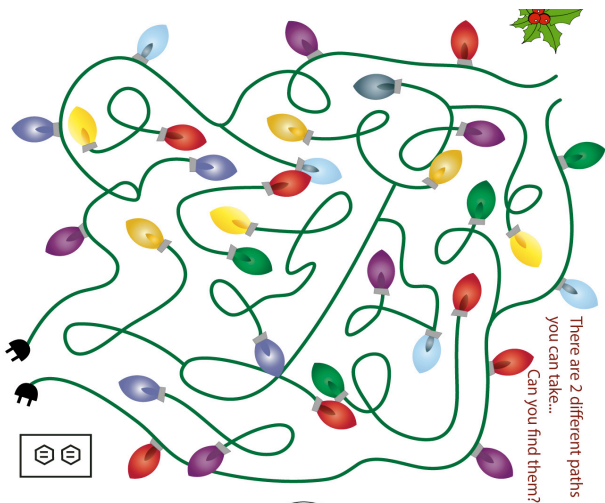

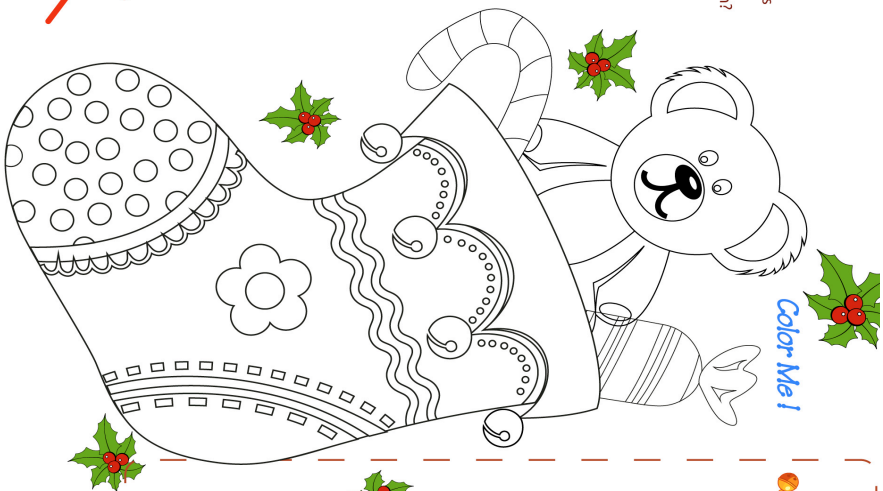
Holiday Lights Maze

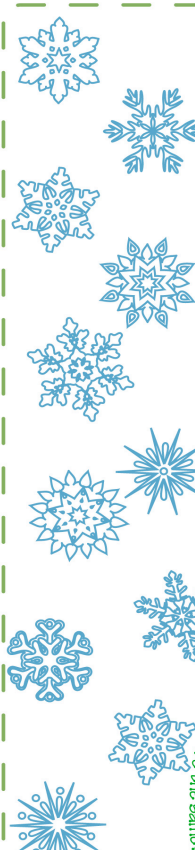

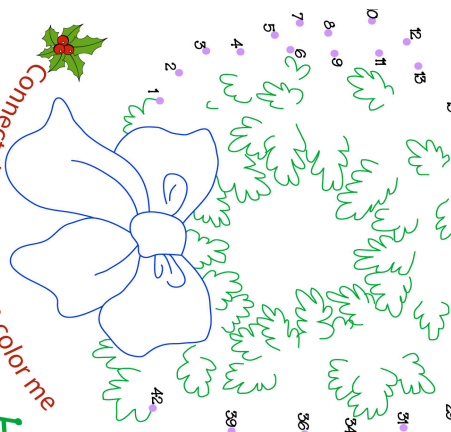
Which one of the Bells is different than the others?
